



- 4. npn (sink) inputs use voltage supplied from the controller's power supply.
- 5. Inputs #0, #2 and #4 can each function as either high-speed counter or as part of a shaft encoder. In each case, high-speed input specifications apply. When used as a normal digital input, normal input specifications
- 6. Inputs #1, #3 and #5 can each function as either counter reset, or as a normal digital input; in either case, specifications are those of a normal digital input.

Shaft encoder




Power supply, pnp (source) inputs




Note 7:






